Coats are sometimes needed, so please remember to send them with your child. Please write your child's name in their coat so that if it gets misplaced we'll know whose it is. Also, if you have not sent in warmer clothes for your child to keep here at school, now is the time to do this.

Drop off

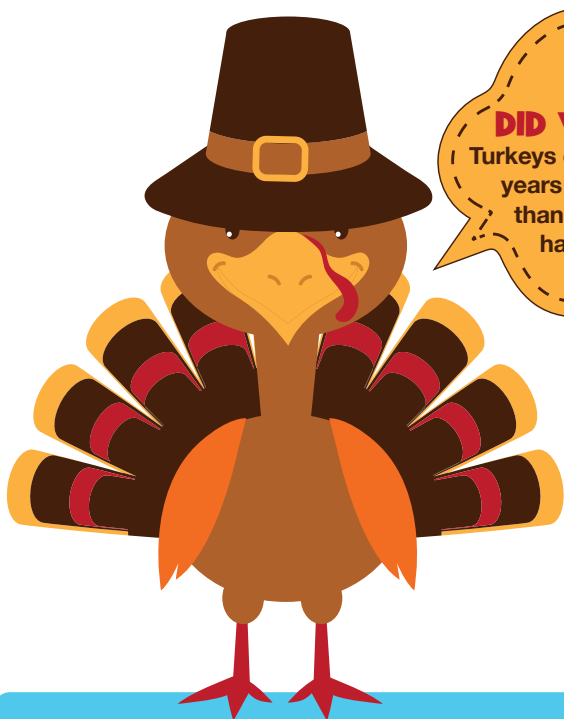
