IMPORTANT THINGS FOR YOU TO KNOW

We're so excited that your kid(s) will be joining us for Focus!

Each day kids need to:

- Eat a hearty breakfast.
- Bring a change of clothing, a towel and an extra bag for wet clothes. (There's a chance they'll get wet every day!)
- Apply sunscreen prior to arrival.
- Wear closed-toe, comfortable shoes.

Parents please remember:

- Stay with your child until the doors open at 8:45 am each morning. Grades 1-4: Auditorium • K4-K5: Pod C • K3: Pod B
- Keep track of your Family Security Code Pick Up Card.
- Show your Family Security Code Pick Up Card to your child's leader when picking up your child.
- If you lose your Family Security Code Pick Up Card, visit the Adventure Week Information Desk in the Concourse to be issued a new card. Please be prepared to show a picture ID.
- If someone else is picking up your child, give them the Family Security Code Pick Up Card.

If you have medication that you need to leave for your kids, please see the included form for instructions on sending in medication.

Kids will be eating snacks every day. If your child is allergic to or unable to eat any of the following snacks, please feel free to send in snacks for them to eat. Please make sure the snacks are peanut and nut free.
