

Abraham Moves to a New Land

Genesis 12:1-8

One day God told Abraham to move to a NEW place. Abraham did not know (shake head "no") where the new place was but God (point up) promised to show him how to get there.

So Abraham and Sarah packed all they had and loaded it all on to camels and donkeys.

Can you say "hee-haw" like the donkeys carrying their things? (Everyone will say "hee-haw")



Each day Abraham and his family had to WAIT for God to tell them where to go.

At night, they would sleep (lay head on hand) in tents and then start walking again in the morning.

Can you pretend to sleep, like Abraham and his family?

(Everyone pretends to sleep)



After they had walked a really long time, God told them to STOP (hold hand in "stop" motion).

Let me hear you all shout "STOP!" (Everyone holds up hand and shouts "STOP!")

Great job! Abraham had to do a lot of waiting, but because he was PATIENT and WAITED WITH A HAPPY HEART, God showed him a new place to live!

When we wait with a HAPPY heart, we are showing God and others that we LOVE them!

Let me hear you say this after me:

(Pause to allow kids to repeat each line)

Wait (tap pretend watch)With A Happy (point to smile)Heart! (both hands over heart)
