ACTIVITY #1 – MOVING BLOCKS

WHAT YOU NEED: Floor tape and building blocks

WHAT YOU DO:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: Place the blocks in a pile on one side of the activity area. Use the floor tape to make a small rectangle on the other side of the activity area.

DURING THE ACTIVITY: Challenge the children to work together to move the blocks to the rectangle.

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: Help the children use the blocks to build a wall inside the rectangle.

WHAT YOU SAY:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: Let's build a wall! I see a perfect place. *(Point to the rectangle.)*

DURING THE ACTIVITY: We need blocks to build our wall. I see some! Let's work together to move the blocks to the rectangle so we can build our wall. *(Do activity.)* Great Job! Now, we can build our wall. Let's work together!

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: Nice work! I love your wall. Today in our Bible story, we'll hear about someone who had help building a wall, too!
