#### Read Psalm 46:1-11 slowly at least twice.

1. Which word or phrase stands out to you? Why?

#### Read Psalm 46:1-3.

- 2. What characteristics of God do you see in this passage?
- 3. What causes you to be afraid or anxious?
- 4. What would cause you to think you can trust God as your refuge and/or strength?

## Read <u>Psalm 46:4-7</u>.

- 5. What does God provide for the *city* in this passage?
- 6. Which provision of God in this passage is most attractive to you? Why?

## Read <u>Psalm 46:8-9</u>.

- 7. What works of the Lord do you notice in this passage?
- 8. What work has God been doing around you recently?

#### Read Psalm 46:10-11.

- 9. Why do you think God says the first phrase in verse 10?
- 10. <u>Verse 11</u> says that God is among us, or with us. What difference does that make to you?
- 11. What step can you take to *Be still* (NLT) or *Cease striving* (NASB) and allow God to reveal Himself more clearly to you?

#### **Soul Training**

**Pause** to REFOCUS on God and ask Him these questions:

Father, what practice or habit will help me refocus on You?

How do You want to change my view of You?
