# **Personal Reflection/Group Discussion**

#### Read <u>Psalm 89:1-2</u>.

- 1. What do you think the psalmist was feeling as he wrote this?
- 2. What are some everyday reminders of God's faithfulness to you?
- 3. Can you think of a time you doubted God's faithfulness? What was happening? What was that like for you? How can times of doubt strengthen our relationship with God?
- 4. If one of your friends said, *God can't be faithful, just look at all the bad things that are happening*, how would you respond?
- 5. What do we learn about faithfulness from these Scriptures?
  - a. <u>Psalm 25:8-10</u>
  - b. Psalm 36:5
  - c. Matthew 24:45-51; Luke 16:10-12
- 6. How will you apply at least one of these truths to your life? See John 8:31-32.

- 7. What are results of being faithful?
- 8. What are results of *not* being faithful?
- 9. Has someone ever broken a promise or commitment to you? What was that like? How did you respond? See <a href="Proverbs 20:6">Proverbs 20:6</a>.

10. What areas of life do you need God to help you become more faithful?
