Conversation Starter

What is one of the most severe illnesses or injuries you've experienced?

Personal Reflection/Group Discussion

Read <u>1 Samuel 5:1-12</u>.

- 1. What is *idolatry* in the way the Bible uses that term? Can you define it in a sentence or two? For further insight, read Exodus 20:3-5; Isaiah 44:19-20; Colossians 3:5.
- 2. How were the Philistines practicing idolatry?
- 3. How did God respond?

Read <u>1 Samuel 6:1-21</u>.

- 4. As the story continues, how did the Philistines respond to their dire situation? How would you summarize their reaction to God's judgment?
- 5. Read <u>vs. 19-21</u> again. After studying this entire story, what would you say is the primary reason for God's anger?

Read Romans 3:19-26.

- 6. Write down at least five things that are true according to this passage. Reflect on and discuss these things with a friend or your Small Group.
- 7. How do God's mercy and justice work together in salvation?
- 8. What is God revealing to you about yourself and about Him this week? How is He leading you to respond?

Soul Training

Sit quietly for a few minutes allowing space for your mind to slow down and your heart to be still. Read <u>Psalm 139:23-24</u>. Ask God to reveal anything in your life that is offensive to Him or that draws your attention away from Him. Be honest with yourself and with God, fully surrendering your life to Him. Thank God for the forgiveness and new life fully available in Jesus.
