

# Family Talk – Pursue Relationship with Jesus

## **LISTEN TOGETHER**

---

Read Genesis 12:1-4. Abram was living comfortably when God called him to leave and go to an unknown place.

1. What do you think Abram may have been feeling when God told him to “Leave your native country, your relatives, and your father’s family, and go to the land that I will show you.”? (v.1)
2. What did God promise Abram? (v.2-3)
3. What would be hard to give up? How would it make you feel if God asked you to give that up? (Parents, God does ask us to give up things, but as you see with Abram, God promises good things to those who diligently seek Him.)
4. What are some things that God promises us? (There are many examples in Scripture, but here are some places to start: Philippians 1:6; 4:7-9, 16)

## **LIVE IT**

---

Parents, faith is the most important concept for your children to understand. God’s word teaches us that “faith comes by hearing and hearing by the word of God.”

*So faith comes from hearing, that is, hearing the Good News about Christ.*  
**Romans 10:17 (NLT)**

As a family, decide on a time to sit and listen to God’s Word through the Bible and Prayer. The first time is the hardest, but God’s Word encourages us that faith will come by hearing. Make this commitment as a family.
