## **Personal Reflection/Group Discussion**

#### Read <u>Psalm 144:1-2</u>.

- 1. Which characteristic of God listed in <u>verses 1-2</u> is most significant to you today? Why?
- 2. Why does the psalmist need God to train him for war and battle?
- 3. What's God training you for, and how's He training you?

#### Read Psalm 144:3-4.

- 4. Why does the psalmist question whether God notices people?
- 5. Why do you think God notices you? Share any Bible verses that support your thoughts (Psalm 8; Romans 5:8, 8:32-39; Hebrews 2, etc.).

#### Read <u>Psalm 144:5-15</u>.

- 6. What does the psalmist believe about God based on the prayer in <u>verses 5-11</u>? Based on the prayer in <u>verses 12-15</u>?
- 7. What would you love God to do in your life or in the lives of the people you love?

- 8. What obstacles are you facing in your pursuit of knowing Jesus better? (vs. 7-8, 11)
- 9. What joys or blessings do we have when our God is the Lord Jesus?
- 10. What are you depending on God to provide today?

## **Soul Training**

**Pause** to REFUEL by reading <u>Ephesians 3:19-20</u>. Ask God to show you how much He loves you. Imagine how your life might look when you're truly experiencing His love.
