

Family Talk – God’s Will

READ TOGETHER

1 Samuel 10:1-27

1. Why do you think Saul didn't share everything Samuel told him with his uncle?
2. Why was Saul hiding when it was time for him to be presented to the people as king of Israel (v. 22)?

LIVE IT

Saul didn't share the news of the kingdom with his uncle, and he hid at the ceremony when it came time to be presented as the king of the people of Israel. Both of these examples highlight Saul's unwillingness to accept his new responsibilities.

The story of Saul illustrates an essential truth:

...it is impossible to please God without faith. Anyone who wants to come to Him must believe that God exists and that He rewards those who sincerely seek Him. (Hebrews 11:6)

Talk with your family about the important link between believing and obeying the things of God.
